## Description

**Journal of Emergency Services & Security Education** is a refereed, international, multidisciplinary journal dedicated to research on and practice in all aspects of learning and education in the area Emergency Services and Homeland Security.

**Journal of Emergency Services & Security Education** will address the nature of emergency service and homeland security issues concerning academic, government, private sector, and society in general, as well as the psychological, social and technological impact of homeland security on individuals, groups and society. The primary aim of the journal is to promote a deeper understanding of how government, academic, and private sector are communicating and effectively dealing with emergency services and homeland security issues.

**Journal of Emergency Services & Security Education** provides a forum for communication among experts from different disciplines in the emergency services and homeland security arena such as: education, government, private industry, information technology, psychology (educational, cognitive, cultural, organizational, social, and developmental), communication, linguistics, sociology and business. The journal welcomes articles reporting on original empirical investigations; extensions of important previous work; critical integrative theoretical and methodological contributions; and synthetic review articles. A preference will be given to empirically-grounded studies. The journal also publishes research and practice notes and book reviews. All papers are rigorously refereed.
